

SSC Grant Program

Metropolitan based Neighbourhood and Community Houses and Centres Explained

All Neighbourhood and Community Houses and Centres (NCHCs) located within metropolitan areas are eligible. Other NCHCs located in towns or cities with a population of more than 15,000 people are also eligible, based on postcode.

The definition of metropolitan areas in this grant program is based on the Local Government electoral boundaries in each state and the definition used by each state in determining metropolitan boundaries. The metropolitan local government areas (LGA) that will be eligible for funding are outlined here for each state.
